"Convocation Notes"			

The symbolic meaning of Burgundy

The color Burgundy is created by mixing the colors of purple and red to achieve a deep hue shade of red. Just like the dark rich like red blood that runs through our veins.

It's velvet, rich and vibrant color evokes a sense of nobility, royalty, and divine purpose. Christians uses the color burgundy in liturgical ceremonies, representing penitence, humility, and mourning. Burgundy and white stoles are worn by priests and ministers in various religious ceremonies as a symbol of their role as Shepherds between God and humanity.

While the Bible may not explicitly mention the color burgundy by name, its deep richness is reminiscent of the blood shed by Jesus Christ on the cross, representing sacrifice, redemption, and salvation. It reminds us of His unwavering love and His willingness to lay down His life for us. It also is associated with the divine presence and authority of God. It symbolizes His sovereignty and power, reminding us of His eternal reign.

In biblical times, the shedding of blood was often associated with, sacrifice, and atonement. It represented both the pain of sin and the redemption offered through the shedding of blood. Crimson and deep red shades were often associated with royalty and nobility, found throughout the Old and New Testaments.

And they clothed him with purple, and patted a crown of thorns, and put it about his head, and began to salute him, Hail, King of the Jews!

Mark 15:17-18

When we see burgundy, let it remind us of the deep passion within us, the transformation that is possible through faith, and our royal calling as children of God. Let it inspire us to pursue an authentic and vibrant relationship with our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

"But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:"

1 Peter 2:9


